The 2-Question Test

1. What did you do with my Son Jesus?

Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?' 2. What did you do with what I gave you?

(Matthew 16:27) For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.
